

1. **Download** - I recommend saving the Wasteland Bootleg PDF to a thumb drive.
2. **Print** - Take the thumb drive to your local printshop. I used Fed-Ex Kinkos for the bootlegs that I printed, but any self service printshop will work. Make sure the printer is set-up for 8.5x11, double sided (flipped along the long edge) and black & white.
3. **Fold** - Now that you've printed the PDF, you'll have a stack of 6 double sided pages. The page on the top of the stack should be the center spread. While keeping the pages in order, fold each in half.
4. **Staple** - Ok, this is the trickiest part. You'll need a long arm stapler to properly bind the zine. Most print shops will let you use theirs if you're not a total jerk. Once you have the stapler in hand, unfold the stack, placing the cover face up. I usually put two staples one inch from the top and bottom of the page along the spine of the zine.
