Beginnings:





Mother Nature was to be a beautiful, strong figure. I aimed to show her power and determination through her fierce look.


Nature is unrelenting. It's all around us. We would have nothing without nature, and nature is one of the sole things that bring us joy and happiness, at least to me.





CREATIVITY takes courage.
