The images must feature relief printed text (letterpress or possibly wood or lino cuts)

Size: A5 - 148 \times 210 mm or 5.8 \times 8.3 inches up to A2 - 420 \times 594 mm or 16.5 \times 23.4 inches. (just about any size but best it is big enough to hang up) just ask if you are unsure.

The works can be older— made in the last 5 years and not exhibited with Love Letters before.

Consider working collaboratively artist/ printer.

2 entries Max.

Deadline: March 31st 2026

Please make sure details are legible

The works will NOT be returned to you as the exhibition will travel throughout New Zealand. After it has been exhibited the works will then be donated to an institution for educational purposes.

If sending internationally please let us know so we are aware it is coming. And email through a picture for catalogue and any print details (including size). * Feel free to combine shipping with other printers you know to reduce cost.

Last time we are tried something new so that *printers can sell work directly to those interested.*
