Through the integration of photography, moving images, audio, experiential prose, and personal testimonials, he strives to deepen his understanding of worldly affairs and the role of contemporary documentary practice. Giovanni holds an MFA in Documentary Media from Toronto Metropolitan University. He shoots assignments and commissions for several editorial and commercial clients, and is a regular contributor to the Toronto Star, Canada's largest daily. Giovanni runs photography workshops, lectures, and talks and teaches photojournalism and visual communication at University of Guelph-Humber. His work has been recognized by the World Press Photo Foundation, Pictures of the Year International, Sony World Photography Awards, Dorothea Lange and Paul Taylor Prize, Lucie Foundation, Paris Photo Prize, News Photographers Association of Canada, Ontario Premier's Awards – and steadily supported through grants from Italian institutions such as ISMEO and MIUR, plus University of Guelph-Humber.
