Charlotte Street's 25th Anniversary Community Block Party

Kansas City, MO, June 15, 2022: Charlotte Street is producing a free community block party to celebrate our 25th Anniversary on Saturday July 16th from 1PM to 5PM at the Charlotte Street Campus located at 3333 Wyoming Street, Kansas City, MO 64111. Guests will enjoy campuswide family-friendly activities, giveaways, interactive art experiences, and ice cream.



The third installation of 25, the Charlotte Street Fellow Anniversary exhibit will also premiere at this event, featuring community engaged public works from Adriane Herman (2000), Kati Toivanen (2001), and Jillian Youngbird (2018), a new mural work from Stephen Proski (2017), and music from Eddie Moore (2016), Jeff Harshbarger (2015), and Marcus Lewis (2018).

Emotional Value Auction in the Kemper Library

Capitalizing on the power of witnessing to release blocks and facilitate letting go, an *Emotional Value Auction* is a participatory witnessed exchange grounded in reciprocity. For the Charlotte Street Block Party, objects will be collected and displayed by Experience Broker and 2000 Charlotte Street Award winner, Adriane Herman - along with written statements from the objects' owners about how they came to own the item and why it is time to let go. No money changes hands; written statements of interest from viewers replace financial bids, foregrounding other metrics of value. Authentic written expression and shared vulnerability are rewarded, and are rewards in themselves.

To release something through this non-monetized event, contact the artist at emotionalvalueauction@gmail.com ASAP. Objects can be delivered to the Charlotte Street welcome desk 12 PM-5 PM Tues-Sat until July 10th, or later by arrangement, and should be accompanied by a photo of the item as well as a written statement about what the item is, how you came to have it, why it is time to let go and anything else you wish to share about it. This statement can be as long or short as you wish. (Releasers don't have to be present during the Auction.)
