As well as capturing the big and little moments, the group shots and the candid, I tend to also act as a bit of a PA for the day and generally just being a source of whatever energy my couples need me to be.

I like my couple portraits to sit in that sweet spot between choreographed and candid with moments of hilarity, intimacy and your own personalities - general direction here and there is all most couples need and I believe it's all about doing what feels lovely and comfortable and making all the magic by simply being your wonderful selves.

Connecting with the wedding and the people involved on a personal level is hugely important in creating important images that will be part of your family legacy.

To ensure you get the most out of your wedding photographs, I send all of my couples a wedding guide when they book me. This is full to the brim with tips and guidance that I've accumulated over my many years of experience in weddings and working with couples.

CAMERA SHY? ME TOO!!

I know, imagine having "awkward human as soon as I have a camera pointed at me" in common with your photographer?!

Seems ironic, doesn't it? It's a curse, I know. But the plus side of it is that I know how most of my couples feel about being photographed - so hopefully you can tell how much I enjoy helping couples to feel comfortable and have fun with me behind the camera and them front and centre. One of my main goals is for people to feel at ease as much as possible when it comes to having their photograph taken, which is why I approach moments with sensitivity and care and avoid making anyone do things that feel too unnatural to them.

If the idea of being photographed is a bit daunting, or if you would just really love some pre-wedding memories captured, you can add on an engagement session to your package for £350.

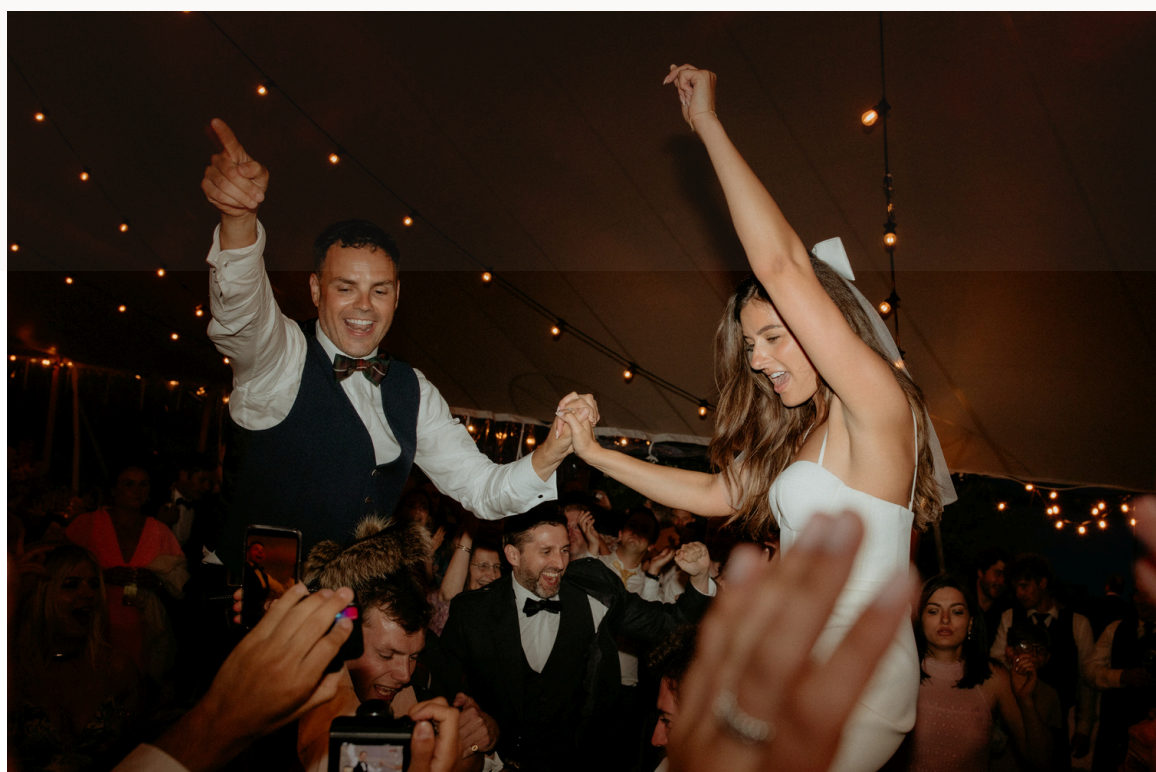
Wedding FULL DAY PACKAGE

My favourite! I get to spend the day with you - from the preparations through to the party getting into full swing!

Coverage from 2 hours before the ceremony through to the first handful of dances (typically 10 hours).

If you're both getting ready onsite or nearby each other, there's also the option to add both sides of preparations rather than just one into your package for £150. This gives you an extra hour of morning coverage without having to hire a 2nd shooter.

Travel included for mainland Scotland up to 60 miles from EH5 (any necessary overnight accommodation will be quoted upon enquiry).

A second photographer gives you even fuller coverage of the day -
Ideal for tight timelines and large guest lists!

Wedding FULL DAY + 2ND PHOTOGRAPHER

All the good stuff from the full day package along with a 2nd photographer for extra coverage of preparations and candid shots throughout the day.

I recommend this one if you would like both sides of preparations covered but you're not getting ready within 5-10 mins drive of each other, if you have a guest list of over 150 day guests and want lots of candid, or if you are planning to have a short afternoon drinks reception.

Wedding HOURLY COVERAGE

Ideal for those wanting less of the day covered, or if you're having a small wedding/city elopement.

Coverage from one to six hours - first hour rate is £375, hourly rate is £300 thereafter.

Hours must be continuous (one dinner hour can be included for £150 instead of £300).

Limited availability for Saturday weddings between 1st of May and 30th September

Travel included for up to 60 miles from EH5 (extra travel/overnight accommodation will be quoted upon enquiry).





Extras

Want to level up your package? Let me know what you're looking for that may be out of the ordinary, otherwise here's a few extra ideas you might want to consider...

Film Photography

You can add a few rolls of film onto your package for £100 per roll (36 exposures) and add a dreamy film element to your wedding gallery.



Albums

Photo albums start from £200. Designed with you every step of the way, lots of choices of covers, layouts and your selection of images from the day. Duplicate and "parent" albums are also available and make for gorgeous gifts!

Highland Experience

Pre- or post-wedding Highland photoshoot for £1,200 where you can wear your wedding outfits or your favourite clothes as we adventure around some beautiful Highland scenery. These shoots typically last around 3-4 hours and location/travel costs quoted upon request & location info.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How & when will we receive our photos?

A: You'll receive a small selection of sneak peeks within 7 days of the wedding. Your photos will then be delivered via an online gallery within 10-12 weeks of your wedding. You can share this with friends & family, order prints and gifts and download your images.

Q: Do I have to order prints through you?

A: I highly recommend ordering prints through the professional lab linked to your gallery, but it isn't required. The difference in quality is huge when it comes to ordering through a professional lab, so I always love to help with prints!

Q: Are you willing to travel?

A: Yes! Definitely! Travel fees are applied if I'm going over 60 miles, which is charged both ways. Destinations that exceed two hours driving time each way may require overnight accommodations.

Q: How do we book?

A: To book, contact me via an e-mail to let me know you'd like to go ahead with booking! If you'd like to meet in person before booking then we can arrange a time to meet up. Once your booking is confirmed you'll fill out a booking form, pay a £500 booking fee and we're all good to go.

Q: What happens after we book?

A: You'll receive a 2nd booking form which is hosted on Google Drive containing all the info I need for the day. We'll arrange a call nearer the wedding to run through this and the finer details of the day!

We'll chat through your vision for the day and what you would like from your photos. Between booking and then, you are more than welcome to message or email for advice on absolutely anything, send me inspo pics on Instagram, and just check in any time you'd like.
