THE 3 FILTERS TO CHOOSING THE RIGHT MAKEUP ARTIST

FILTER 1

NATURAL, SKIN-LIKE RESULTS (NOT OVERDONE)

- Do their brides still look like themselves, not masked or overly made up?
- Does the makeup still look like real skin where you can see dimension, texture, and life (not flat, heavy, or overly smoothed)?
- Do their results hold up in professional wedding images—not just phone photos?
- Even in their least strong image, does the makeup still feel beautiful and balanced?

FILTER 2

PERFORMANCE IN HEAT, HUMIDITY & REAL CONDITIONS

- Does the makeup still look fresh hours later, not just right after application?
- Do they speak about how makeup wears, not just how it looks?
- Do their brides appear comfortable, natural, and never “melting”?
- Does the makeup translate beautifully across lighting: sunlight, indoors, and flash photography?

THE 3 FILTERS TO CHOOSING THE RIGHT MAKEUP ARTIST

FILTER 3

SKILL, COMMUNICATION & DESTINATION EXPERIENCE

- Can they confidently work across different skin tones, undertones, and ethnic features (e.g. Asian eyes, deeper complexions) while still keeping the result natural and refined?
- Is there clear evidence of diverse clients in their portfolio?
- Do they offer a consultation to understand your vision and guide your inspiration images?
- Do you feel heard and not like you're being given a "standard look"?

DESTINATION BRIDE NOTE

If you're considering a resort makeup artist, keep in mind that you're often unable to choose or preview the specific artist assigned to you.

Reviewing a consistent portfolio and having direct communication with your artist can make a significant difference in how confident and how much like yourself and feel on your wedding day.

Before You Book, Read This

Most brides choose based on photos alone, but photos don't tell you how makeup feels, wears, or translates in real conditions.

If You Can't Schedule a Trial...

That's completely normal for destination weddings. The key is choosing an artist whose work is consistent, who listens well, and who can bring your vision to life with confidence on the day.
