Those students must have plans to attend to a two or four-year college or university. The application is complete once all of the criteria outlined below are met for consideration. We invite all eligible High School graduating seniors to apply.

To be eligible for this award the applicant must:

- Must be a High School graduating senior;
- Have a Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale;
- Provide documentation of their G.P.A. by an official transcript or letter of verification signed by a school administrator;
- Provide one letter of recommendation from a school staff member at the school of attendance;
- Provide one letter of recommendation from a person in the community;
- Provide a one-page personal statement that highlights the applicant's views on current issues that are important to him/her which outlines their motivation to seek a higher education;
- Complete and submit application

Once the transcript (or other verification), letters of recommendation, and personal statement are received and reviewed, the application process is complete and a telephone or personal interview will be scheduled. Those awarded a scholarship will need to provide verification of college acceptance and/or enrollment to the scholarship committee prior to receipt of the award. Scholarship awards will be formally presented at the school's awards night to be scheduled at a later date. We will be giving \$250.00, \$500.00, and \$1000 scholarship awards.
