



Frei Rezakhanlou Architects Chermignon School, Kindergarten and Multipurpose Hall

Chermignon, Switzerland, 2010

Serving as the connection point between five small villages, this school complex provides a variety of outdoor spaces for children to play in, as well as crucial meeting spaces for people from the region to gather. Built on a steep site, the buildings and retaining walls are set around a central forum. The school and the hall share the same roof, which facilitates the use of the sports hall by pupils and vice-versa. The kindergarten overlooks a spectacular alpine vista across the valley and provides a direct access to the main playground.
