Join Wanderlust Imagery for a morning at Glenworth Valley Horse Riding for the Running of The Horses.

Meet at the Glenworth Valley Horse Riding carpark at 5.45am, following which guests will be met by riders on horseback and escorted to the creek crossing.

The walk is along a level road, then grassed paddock, and should take no longer than 5-10 minutes. We will receive a safety briefing from staff. Please comply with all directions.

There will be 3 crossings, with the last crossing by 6.50am. The horses then make their way to the holding yards to be saddled and prepared for work that day.

At 6.45am there will be two riders available for Australian stockman action shots, either still shots in the paddock or riding across the creek crossing.

7am the shoot concludes, where we can take in the general scenery and freshen up before a 7.30am breakfast with a bacon and egg roll, warm muffin, tea and coffee.

The morning concludes at 8.00am

Subject to availability, Robin will bring along a Sony lens and camera loan kit, for those interested in trying out some Sony gear. Leave a drivers license and be prepared to share the gear around.
