## The (Flexible) Itinerary

The itinerary and flight paths selected are subject to change and may vary to accommodate weather conditions and ground conditions around the lakes and wetlands.

18<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> October, 2024

### Day 1 – Friday 18<sup>th</sup>

Arrive in Swan Hill on the afternoon or early evening from 3pm.  
Sunset shoot or wildlife photography at local wetlands  
Dinner in Swan Hill.

### Day 2 – Saturday 19<sup>th</sup>

An early breakfast at our accommodation, then a day spent in our studio at Swan Hill Airport with flights over the salt lakes and Lightroom or Photoshop editing tuition.  
Lunch is provided.  
Dinner self catered or join a group outing to Swan Hill.  
Astro photography (subject to weather).

### Day 3 – Sunday 20<sup>th</sup>

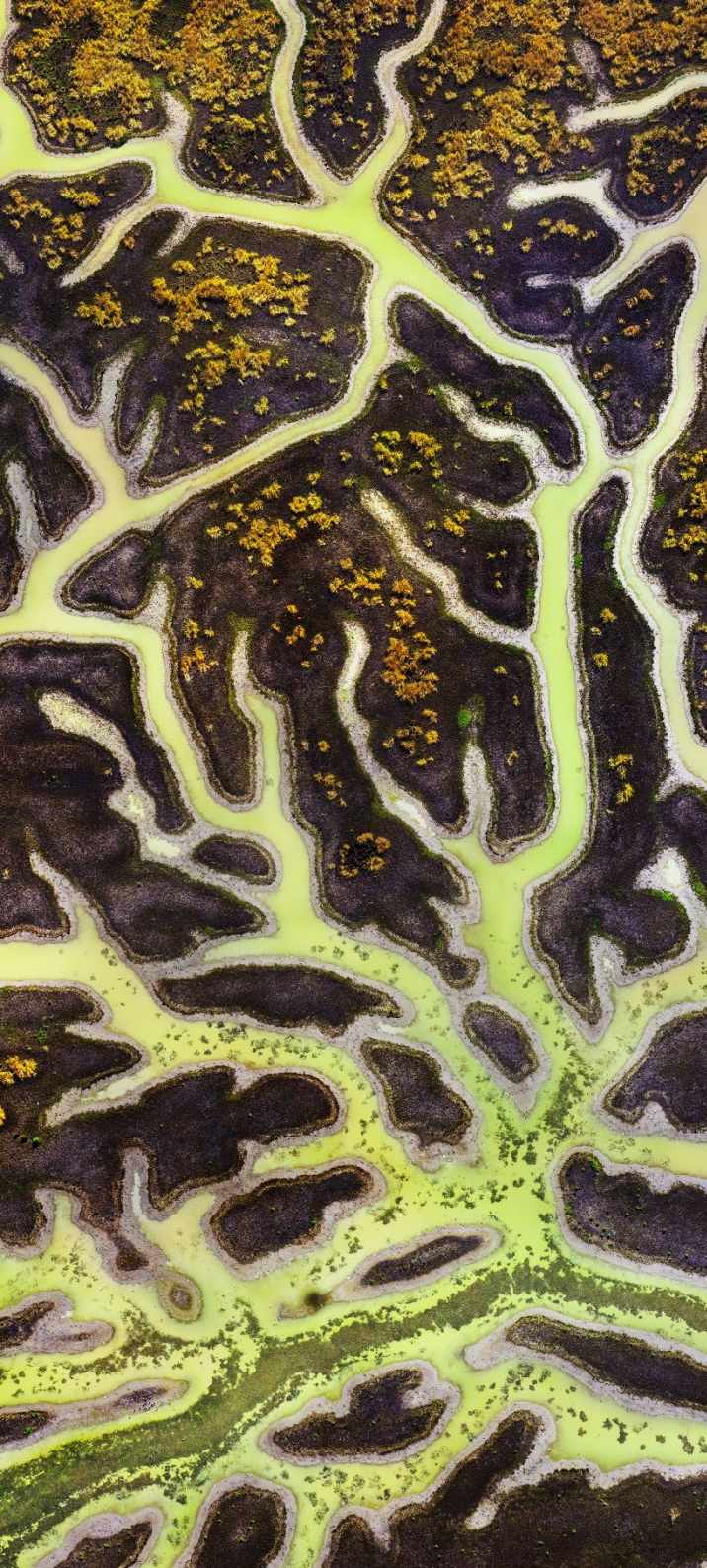
Rinse and repeat, however today we explore the Gayini Wetlands.

### Day 4 – Monday 21<sup>st</sup>

Sunrise Shoot then breakfast at our accommodation before checking out at 10:00am.

- **Transport to and from Swan Hill**

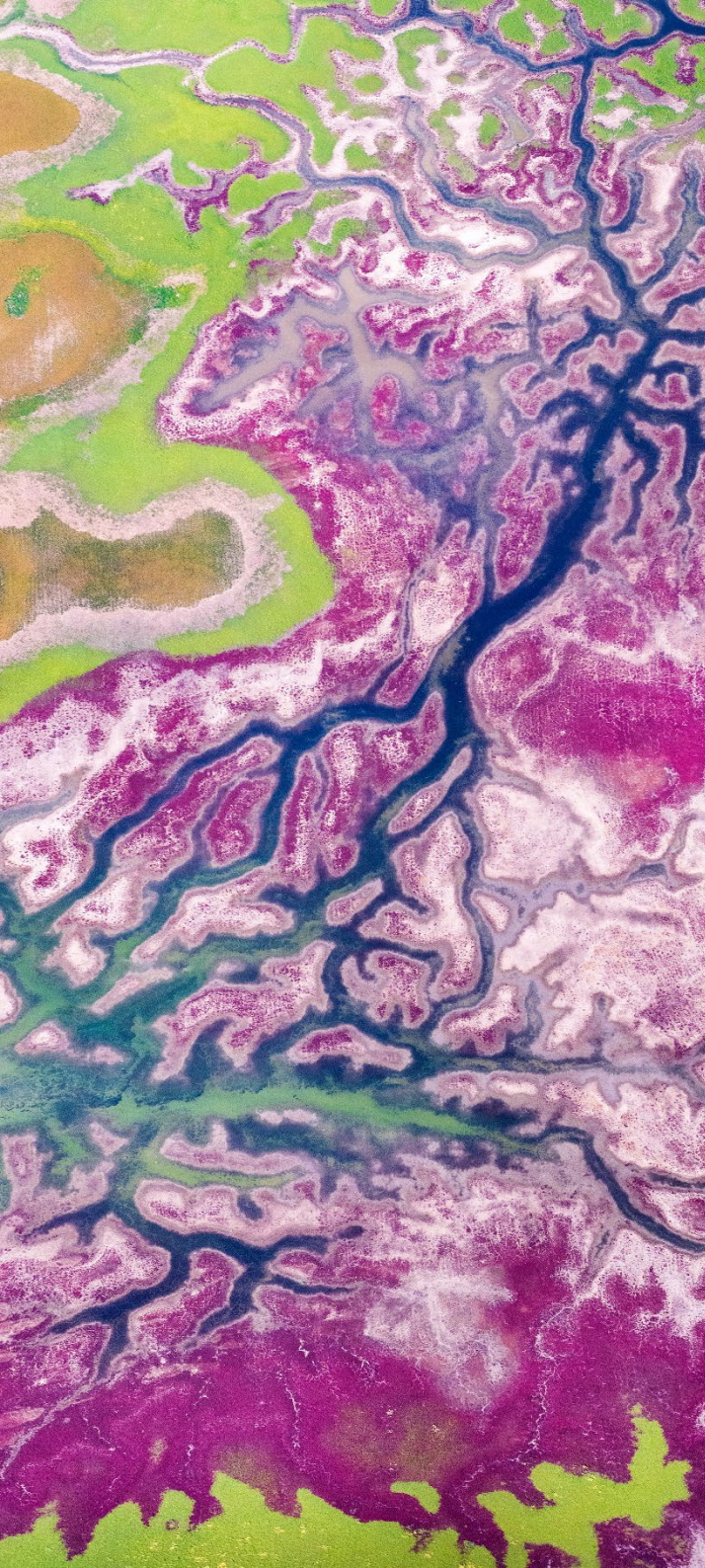

- Unlike larger tours you will be part of a small group with plenty of time for one-on-one time to discuss camera settings, composition, visual direction and your love of aerial landscape photography.
- The itinerary is a guide, and we may change locations based on weather and changing photographic opportunities. Our pilots are skilled local professionals.
- An unfolding landscape that provides ample opportunity to test and fine tune your creative and abstract compositional skills.
- Workshop leaders who are passionate about photography with some cool tips and tricks when it comes to editing.

- All levels of fitness can be accommodated.  
Some flexibility is required to board and exit the light aircraft.

## What To Bring

- Camera      Whatever you have.  
We also help with iPhone photography and videography.
- Tripod      For land based sunrise, sunset and astrophotography.
- Lenses      12mm f/2.8 for astrophotography and landscapes  
70-200mm for wildlife  
24-70mm for aerial photography
- Silicon Hood      Light plane flights will be “doors on”  
so we have found that a silicon hood  
can ensure reflection free photography
