

#### **Getting Around**

The Faroe Islands are comprised of 18 smaller islands. We will be using a comfortable minivan for the tour. Access between the main islands is made easier by four subsea tunnels:

Vágatunnilin, Norðoyartunnilin, Eysturoyartunnilin, and Sandoyartunnilin.

**Vágatunnilin** connects the western island of Vágar (Airport) to the island of Streymoy (capital Tórshavn).

**Norðoyatunnilin** connects the northern island of Borðoy (Klaksvík) to the island of Eysturoy (Leirvík).

**Eysturoyartunnilin** connects the island of Streymoy with Eysturoy (two towns: Strendur and Runavík). Streymoy with the island of Sandoy.

The drive from our accommodation in Tórshavn to most of our destinations takes less than an hour. The airport to Tórshavn is around 45 minutes.

#### Weather

Dress for windy days with potential for rain and snow. The average maximum temperature in February is 5°C (41 °F).

The roads are regularly cleared if snow falls.

# The (Flexible) Itinerary in more Detail - subject to change and will vary to accommodate wind and weather conditions.

Saturday 21st	The villages of Gásadalur and Bøur	We start with the island of Vágar, and a visit to the small village of Gásadalur. Walk on marked nature trails to enjoy the view over Tindhólmur, along with the Múlafossur waterfall that pours into the ocean.
Sunday 22nd	Trælanípa, Bøsdalafoss and The Giant and The Witch.	The hike along the lake is an easy walk along the old path to the peat field. At the end of the lake is Bøsdalafossur waterfall, which flows directly into the Atlantic Ocean. Continue on to the village of Tjørnuvík, surrounded by steep mountains, and the Giant and the Witch. Cross the bridge, that connects the islands of Streymoy and Eysturoy.
Monday 23rd	Gjógv and Crown Princess Mary's Bench.	Enjoy the day in the scenic village of Gjógv, known for its unique natural harbour and view of the island of Kalsoy. At the end of the crevice, enjoy the view from Crown Princess Mary's Bench.
Tuesday 24th	Northern Islands and the village of Viðareiði	We take the tunnel to the fishing town of Klaksvík. Then drive to the small village of Kunoy. We then continue to the island of Viðoy to visit Viðareiði the most northern village in the Faroe Islands.
Wednesday 25th	Kalsoy and the Seal Woman	We travel Klaksvík by ferry to the island of Kalsoy, popularly called the Recorder. The 12-kilometer long road on the island winds through four tunnels and connects the islands four villages. We visit Mikladalur and the sculpture of the Seal Woman, and then on to the village of Trøllanes far to the north.
Thursday 26th	Skálafjørðin Fjord	We visit Oyndarfjørður to see the Rocking Stones, and Runavík for the old Rectory in the village of Nes. From Nes we drive towards Æðuvík, for a walk to the windmills. In the village of Toftir, there is a yarn store called Navia which has a large selection of Faroese sweaters.
Friday 27th	The island of Sandoy	We take the under sea tunnel to visit the Island of Sandoy. Walk from Skopun to the dramatic Liraberg Cliff coastline
Saturday 28th	Tórshavn and cultural center Kirkjubøur	Enjoy the day in Tórshavn, and the village of Kirkjubøur that is the Faroe Islands' historical and cultural centre. The farmhouse, Kirkjubøgarður is home to a family who for 17 generations have run the farmstead and ecclesiastic site.  See the unfinished Magnus Cathedral and the small medieval church of St.Olav.

#### **Travel Notes:**

Ensure you take out travel insurance for the tour, as weather regularly delays travel plans to and from the Faroe Islands.

When organizing travel to and from the tour, allow to arrive at least one day beforehand, and to depart at least one day after conclusion.



## What to Expect

- An extraordinary landscape experience and being part of a smaller group which enables plenty of time for one-on-one time to discuss photography composition and your love of the landscape.
- We stay in the same accommodation in Tórshavn for the duration of the tour, with most locations within an hour travel time, enabling time to sit and absorb the landscape without the need to rush to the next location.
   This also allows a buffer for weather conditions.
- The itinerary is a guide, and we expect to change locations based on weather and changing photographic opportunities.
